Registration:

Training activities at National Academy training sessions are not open to the general public. Attendance is limited to FBI and National Academy graduates. Participants must have paid their 2023 National and Local Chapter NA dues. Any other law enforcement and/or criminal justice personnel who wish to participate in the training conference must obtain prior approval from Special Agent Michael Mrachek, the National Academy Coordinator for FBI, Kansas City, and/or Erik Holland, FBINAA Kansas/Western Missouri Chapter President. Spouses will be welcome at most sessions of the Conference and FBI National Academy selectees are eligible to register.

On-site registration for the conference will be held at the Bluemont Hotel on Tuesday, April 18, 2023, from 3:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m. and on Wednesday, April 19, 2023, from 7:15 a.m. until 8:00 a.m. in the Pre-Function Room on the top floor. Registration badges and training program materials will be issued on-site at the time of registration with the conference.

Refunds:

Records are maintained on all advance registration fees. In the event of an emergency cancellation, your refund will be issued upon receipt of written request.
