Chief Kuehl has served as Chief of Police in Raytown since April of 2020.

Prior to that, he retired as Deputy Chief of the Kansas City Missouri Police Department. During his 34+ years of service with KCPD, Chief Kuehl's executive command assignments included both the Professional Development and Research Bureau, where he was responsible for all training, policy development and special projects and the Patrol Bureau, which included oversight of six patrol divisions and special operations. Some of his other assignments include SWAT, Investigations, Information Technology, Logistical Support and the 911 Call Center.

Chief Kuehl is currently an adjunct professor at Graceland University and serves as a guest lecturer for the School for Command Preparation at the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth.
