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**Steve Ijames**

Steve Ijames has been a police officer since 1979; retiring as an assistant chief with the Springfield, Missouri Police Department. Since then he has served as chief of police in two Missouri municipalities, and currently serves as a trainer and operations officer for a Missouri Sheriff's department. He has served in, supervised, and commanded a variety of assignments including uniformed patrol, criminal investigations, undercover narcotics, and Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT). He was an original member of the National Tactical Officers Association (NTOA) board of directors, and created the less lethal force (impact projectiles, chemical munitions, and noise flash diversionary devices) instructor/trainer programs for the NTOA and the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP). Steve is the author of the IACP National Policy Center model policies involving those technologies as well as TASER, hostage situations, barricaded subjects, and their position papers on SWAT and patrol rifles.

Steve has provided lethal/less lethal force, TASER, Tactical/patrol Command, and counter terrorism training on behalf of the IACP and the U.S. Department of State across North America and in over 30 other countries.

Steve has served on a variety of high-profile critical incident and investigative police commissions, including the Stern Commission in Boston and the Rand Commission for NYPD on Firearm Discharges. He has conducted numerous independent case reviews for prosecutors and attorneys general; as well as assessments, reviews, and audits of state and local police agencies.

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Steve has also reviewed approximately 3,000 use of force cases for police agencies such as the Los Angeles, Chicago, Phoenix, and Philadelphia Police Departments-and provides policy, training, and civil/criminal litigation consulting in a wide variety of tactical, resistance control, special operations, and agency structure related areas. He has served as a police practices/use of force expert on a number of significant police/citizen interactions in the United States, including the Michael Brown case in Ferguson, Missouri, the George Floyd case in Minneapolis, and the Daunte Wright (TASER/gun confusion) case in Brooklyn Center, Minnesota.

Steve has a bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice, a master's degree in Public Administration, and is a graduate of the 186th FBI National Academy.

Andy Lay has been the Chief Division Counsel (CDC) for the FBI's St. Louis Field office since December 2020. Before joining the FBI, CDC Lay worked as an Assistant United States Attorney for the U.S. Department of Justice from 1998-2020, handling primarily white collar fraud cases. CDC Lay also represented federal agencies regarding FOIA litigation, employment disputes, and state use of force investigations. Before his service as an AUSA, CDC Lay worked for the Missouri Attorney General's office and as an associate at a large Midwestern law firm. CDC Lay graduated from the Washington University School of Law in St. Louis, Missouri in 1992, and has an undergraduate degree from Georgetown University.

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**Scott Macke**

Scott Macke has been a Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) Special Agent (SA) since September 2009. Following graduation from the FBI academy, SA Macke was assigned to the Los Angeles Field Office where he primarily conducted criminal enterprise investigations targeting violent street-based gangs and was also a full-time FBI LA SWAT operations coordinator. SA Macke is currently assigned to FBI Kansas City Squad 2 where he conducts public corruption investigations. SA Macke is an FBI Firearm Instructor, Senior Tactical Instructor, ALERRT Instructor (Active Shooter) and FBI SWAT Operator, among other collateral duties. In March 2020, SA Macke attended the FBI's initial Investigative Genealogy (IG) Course. Since then, SA Macke has participated in numerous IG investigations across the United States resulting in resolutions to decades old cold case murders. Prior to the FBI, SA Macke was a Police Officer with the City of Shawnee, Kansas for approximately four and a half years.

Sean McCarthy has served as Continuing Education Coordinator since 2005 for the St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department.
